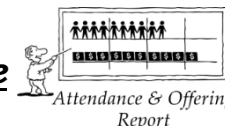
on their way to school. Thank you for thinking about these children when you are shopping.

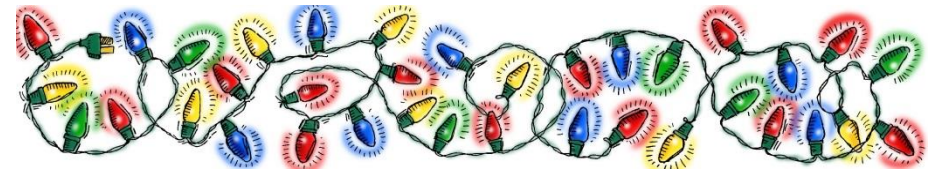
