

PEAK WEEK

Pastor Matthew Martens, Interim

The approaching Holy Week is the **Peak Week** of the Christian year, when we remember, re-enact, re-live the events by which Christ redeemed the world. As we enter into the Passion of our Lord, we experience spiritual rebirth and renewal to carry Jesus' mission forward into the world.

<u>Palm/Passion Sunday, April 9,</u> our worship begins joyfully with the palm procession, but then moves quickly to the Reading of the Passion Account of our Lord according to Matthew, so that we enter into Holy Week mindful of all our Lord went through to accomplish our salvation. The sermon is: *God Makes us Strongest in the Weak Places*.

Maundy Thursday, April 13, 7:30 pm, we gather to recall Jesus washing the feet of his disciples thereby "leading by example," and then he institutes the Lord's Supper which will forever fortify his people to live the Christian life. The message is, *The Two Washings of Holy Week (Pilate's Handwashing and Jesus' Foot washing)*. The service closes with the stripping of the altar.

Good Friday, April 14, 7:30 pm, in this solemn and meditative service, we hear the Passion Account according to John, offer the Bidding Prayer, and experience the Cross Procession, and conclude with an act of devotion at the Cross.

Easter Sunday, April 16, 7:30 am, Easter Sunrise Service begins this day of supreme joy! The Youth lead the service of the word, which is followed by Holy Communion. Then everyone is invited to the 8:30 Sunrise Breakfast. The Festival Worship is at 9:30 am, when with brass and choir and procession we shout our alleluias at the Feast of Victory for our God! The message is, "He Goes Before You to Galilee," and Holy Communion is celebrated.

We join with Christians throughout the world in the great and holy week that culminates in the central celebration of our faith: the Lord's passage from death to new life—by which we receive his life-giving love.
